mark the 100th anniversary of the WW1 Armistice,

Redruth Town Council, Celtic Male Ensemble and RAOST
Singers are all involved. As well as the two choirs there will
be spoken word and instrumental solos and an Act of
Remembrance. All participants are giving their time free of
charge so that all proceeds go to the Poppy Appeal. Tickets
are £10 to include a souvenir programme and available from
