All are welcome to attend the Treleigh School KS2 Assembly at St Stephen Treleigh on Wednesday 7th November at 10.30 am.

Carmarth North Deanery Synod at St. Mary's Portreath - 7.00 pm on Wednesday the 7th November. There will be a presentation by three Diocesan Interns who will be accompanied by Reverend Angela Brown.

Festival of Remembrance - St Andrew's Redruth, 7.00 pm on Saturday 10th November - A very special event to mark the 100th anniversary of the WW1 Armistice, instigated by us at St Andrew's and supported by The RBL, Redruth Town Council, Celtic Male Ensemble and RAOST Singers. As well as the two choirs there will be spoken word, instrumental solos and an Act of Remembrance. All participants are giving their time free of charge so all proceeds go to the Poppy Appeal. Tickets £10 to include a souvenir programme & available from Caspar. Please contact Caspar if you can volunteer to steward etc on the day.

A note from Father Peter about next Sunday's Services - Christchurch Lanner will be part of a united act of remembrance. This will start with a procession from the Old Band Room at 10.30 am and will travel through the village to the village Lych Gate for the traditional wreath laying and two minutes silence at 11.00 am. This will be followed by a service in the Lanner Methodist Chapel.

FLAPJACK will remember at an act of remembrance which will begin at 10.45 am with the dedication of a memorial plaque at the Four Lanes Post Office and the reading of the names of those from the community who died in WW1. This will be followed by a procession to the St Andrew Pencoys Church Lych Gate at 11.20 am, where the names of those who died in WW2 will be read and wreaths will be laid at both the Lych Gate and the WW1 war grave of Sidney Stuckey Brown in Pencoys Cemetery. This will be followed by Holy Communion at St Andrew Pencoys at 11.30 am. Finally, at 1.00 pm there will be a WW1 Armistice Day lunch in the Four Lanes Chapel.
