I would like to take this opportunity to thank Caspar for his support regarding this and during my time in the job – I have enjoyed working with him and all the Benefice Team. You will find a brief overview of the role below, but please contact Caspar for an informal chat to find out more about the job. It's possible the finalised role may change a little from what follows, but the main areas of responsibility as Benefice Administrator have been:

- Production and printing of weekly pew sheet
- Monitoring and replying to emails received
- Collation of weddings and baptisms booked - sending details to each church
- Provision of banns details to be called to the relevant churches
- Sending out correspondence regarding wedding fees and monitoring fees received
- Production of monthly calendar details for magazine
- Drawing up the quarterly readings list

Eight hours per week – working from home using a supplied laptop, with some time spent in the office to carry out printing and any other admin duties.
