**Christchurch Lanner's Patronal Festival** - we are having a 'Car Awareness Day' to mark our Patronal Festival on Sunday, 25<sup>th</sup> November at 3.00 pm. Our aim is reduce vehicle pollution by inviting people to share cars, walk or cycle to the Patronal Festival where possible.
