Christchurch Lanner's Patronal Festival - we are having a 'Car Awareness Day' to mark our Patronal Festival on Sunday, 25th November at 3.00 pm. Our aim is reduce vehicle pollution by inviting people to share cars, walk or cycle to the Patronal Festival where possible. This initiative is part of the Green Church Kernow 'Environmental Award Scheme', which encourages churches to implement a range of environmental recommendations. Holding the Car Awareness Day will bring Christchurch one step further to achieving a Bronze Award under the scheme! A sign-up form is available in church for anyone who is able to offer a car lift and anyone who requires a lift.

The Festival of St Andrew will be celebrated at Pencoys Church at 7.00 pm on the 30th November. This festival will use a rite, authorised by the Bishop and uses elements of both the Methodist and Anglican liturgies. The liturgy will be a concelebration with both Father Peter and Reverend Carole Holmes. Reverend Carole's status as our Methodist Superintendent is the equivalent of an Anglican Bishop.

The Consecration of the Reverend Canon Philip Mountstephen - this will take place on Friday the 30th November at 11.00 am at St. Paul's Cathedral. At the same time, there will be a solemn Holy Communion Service at St Andrew Pencoys, when the prayer of consecration will be read. All are welcome to attend.
